

MISDEMEANOR

Meaning: A misdemeanor is a minor criminal offense that is less serious than a felony, often punishable by fines or short-term imprisonment.

1. The judge decided to impose a fine rather than jail time for the misdemeanor.
2. After the incident, he was charged with a misdemeanor for disturbing the peace.
3. She realized that what she thought was a minor offense was actually classified as a misdemeanor.
