Meaning: To misdescribe means to inaccurately or incorrectly describe something or someone, often leading to misunderstandings or misrepresentations.

1. It is important not to misdescribe the features of the product during the marketing campaign.
2. The witness's testimony could misdescribe the events of that night, leading to confusion.
3. If you misdescribe the project requirements, it could result in costly delays.
4. She feared that her inability to articulate the situation might misdescribe the severity of the issue.
5. To misdescribe the intentions of the author would undermine the entire message of the book.
