Meaning: Misdirect: to lead someone to a wrong conclusion or to divert attention away from the correct path or information.

1. The detective realized that the false information had been deliberately used to misdirect the investigation.
2. In his attempt to clarify the situation, he accidentally misdirected his colleagues to the wrong conclusion.
3. The marketing campaign was so confusing that it seemed designed to misdirect potential customers.
4. She felt that the media coverage was intended to misdirect public attention from the real issues.
5. They planned to misdirect the enemy forces by staging a decoy operation far from their true location.
