Meaning: Misenter (verb): to incorrectly input or enter information, particularly data such as email addresses or payment details.

1. The email was misentered, causing a delay in the project timeline.
2. She realized she had misentered her credit card information while shopping online.
3. After checking the data, it became clear that several client addresses were misentered.
4. To avoid confusion, always double-check for misentered details before submitting forms.
5. The accountant had to correct a misentered amount that affected the financial report.
