

MISIMAGINATION

Meaning: Misimagination refers to a flawed or incorrect conception or interpretation of an idea or situation, particularly in creative contexts.

1. Misimagination often leads to misunderstandings in the creative process.
2. The artist's misimagination of the scene resulted in a painting that felt disconnected from reality.
3. She realized that her misimagination of the project's scope had caused unnecessary delays.
4. His misimagination of her intentions fueled unnecessary conflict between them.
5. In literature, misimagination can distort the author's intended message, leaving readers confused.
