Meaning: To misinstruct means to give incorrect or misleading instructions or guidance.

1. The teacher was careful not to misinstruct her students during the complex lesson.
2. Due to the misinstruction from the manual, we struggled to assemble the furniture correctly.
3. Even a small error in the initial brief can misinstruct an entire team on the project's goals.
4. He felt frustrated after realizing that he had been misinstructed about the exam format.
5. To avoid misinstruction, the coach provided a detailed explanation of the training drills.
