Meaning: MISINTERPRET: to understand or explain something incorrectly or in a way that deviates from its intended meaning.

1. The teacher was worried that some students might misinterpret the complex poem.
2. In her eagerness to defend her point, she seemed to misinterpret his words entirely.
3. It's easy to misinterpret someone's intentions when communication is unclear.
4. The news report could easily misinterpret the facts if not carefully fact-checked.
5. They realized too late that their disagreement stemmed from a misinterpretation of the original agreement.
