

# MISJOIN

*Meaning: Misjoin: the incorrect combination or association of parties or elements in a legal case or data structure, resulting in confusion or errors.*

1. The attorney argued that the court had misjoined the parties in the case, leading to confusion.
2. A misjoin in the database can result in inaccurate data retrieval and analysis.
