Meaning: Mislen (noun): a misunderstanding or misinterpretation of information or intentions.

1. The artist's unique style often led to a mislen in understanding her true intentions.
2. After the meeting, there was a mislen about the project's deadlines among the team members.
3. His choice of words created a mislen that left everyone confused about the final decision.
4. The mislen in the instructions caused several participants to complete the task incorrectly.
5. Even a small mislen in the recipe can dramatically change the flavor of the dish.
