Meaning: MISMARK (verb): to incorrectly label or designate something, often resulting in errors in identification or classification.

1. The package was returned because it was mismarked as having the wrong address.
2. During the audit, we discovered that several items had been mismarked in the inventory system.
3. She realized she had mismarked her answers on the exam, leading to a lower score than expected.
4. The shipping department quickly corrected the mismarked labels before dispatching the packages.
