

MISPERSUADE

Meaning: MISPERSUADE: to attempt to convince someone to adopt a false belief or opinion, often through deception or manipulation.

1. The attempt to mispersuade her colleagues backfired when they saw through the deception.
2. While he thought he could mispersuade his friends to join him, they remained unconvinced.
3. Her efforts to mispersuade the audience only strengthened their resolve against her argument.
4. He realized that trying to mispersuade anyone would only damage his reputation in the long run.
5. Mispersuading others can lead to a breakdown of trust that is difficult to rebuild.
