

# MISPOINT

*Meaning: MISPOINT (verb): to aim or direct something inaccurately or incorrectly, resulting in failure to hit the intended target or capture the desired image.*

1. The archer realized too late that he had mispointed his arrow, missing the target entirely.
2. In her excitement, she mispointed the camera, capturing only the empty space behind her friends.
3. Due to a mispoint in the design, the new software failed to function as intended.
4. He tried to correct the mispoint in his argument during the debate, but it was too late to change opinions.
5. The teacher explained how a mispoint in his calculations led to the incorrect answer on the test.
