Meaning: Misrelate: to incorrectly connect or interpret facts, ideas, or intentions, leading to misunderstandings or misrepresentations.

1. If you misrelate the facts in your report, it could lead to serious misunderstandings.
2. The artist's intention was often misrelated by critics who failed to grasp the underlying themes.
3. In her explanation, she seemed to misrelate the events, causing confusion among her listeners.
4. When studying history, it's crucial not to misrelate the causes and effects of significant events.
5. He misrelated the story during his presentation, which resulted in a lack of clarity and engagement.
