Meaning: Misseek: to pursue or search for something incorrectly or in a misguided manner.

1. The detective seemed to misseek the true motives behind the suspect's actions.
2. In his eagerness to solve the puzzle, he often misseeks clues that lead him astray.
3. When planning the event, she realized she had misseeking the guests' dietary restrictions.
4. His tendency to misseek the root of the problem often resulted in wasted time and effort.
5. The team misseeks collaboration opportunities, focusing instead on individual achievements.
