Meaning: MISSTATE: To express or present information inaccurately or incorrectly.

1. The witness was careful not to misstate any of the facts during her testimony.
2. In his haste to summarize the article, he inadvertently misstated the author's main argument.
3. It's important to verify your sources to avoid misstating information in your report.
4. She was criticized for misstatement of the statistics in her presentation.
5. The lawyer had to correct the misstate in the contract before it could be signed.
