Meaning: Misswear (verb): To express or convey one's intentions or commitments inaccurately or misleadingly, often due to pressure or misunderstanding.

1. Some people may misswear their intentions when they are under pressure.
2. The athlete was careful not to misswear his endorsement commitments.
3. It's easy to misswear your feelings when trying to keep a straight face.
4. During the debate, he seemed to misswear his arguments, causing confusion among the audience.
5. She didn't mean to misswear her loyalty, but her actions spoke otherwise.
