Meaning: Mistime: to incorrectly time an action or event, leading to an undesirable or unsuccessful outcome.

1. He managed to mistime his jump, resulting in a disheartening fall.
2. The athlete was frustrated after he mistimed his sprint at the starting gun.
3. If you mistime your presentation, you might lose the audience's attention.
4. She often mistimes her cooking, leading to undercooked or burnt meals.
5. The director worried that he might mistime the climactic scene in the film.
