Meaning: Miswear (verb): to wear an item of clothing or accessory incorrectly or inappropriately, such as putting it on upside down or mismatching it with other items.

1. He tends to miswear his glasses, putting them on upside down.
2. In a hurry, she often miswears her shoes, ending up with mismatched pairs.
3. It's easy to miswear a garment when all the labels are faded and unreadable.
4. After the party, he realized he had misworn his friend's jacket by mistake.
5. She laughed when she noticed she had misworn her shirt backward all day.
