Meaning: Modius: a unit of measurement for dry volume, typically used to denote a specific quantity of grain or other agricultural products.

1. The farmer filled a modius with freshly harvested grain for the market.
2. During the feast, each guest was served a modius of rice alongside their main course.
3. The ancient text described the modius as a standard measure for both dry and liquid goods.
4. In historical accounts, a modius was often used to gauge the wealth of a household based on its stored grains.
5. The archaeologist discovered a beautifully preserved modius at the excavation site, shedding light on trade practices of the past.
