

# MONONOMIAL

*Meaning: A monomial is an algebraic expression that contains only one term, which may include constants, variables, and non-negative integer exponents.*

1. A monomial consists of a single term, which may include variables raised to non-negative integer powers.
2. In algebra, students often encounter monomials as the building blocks of polynomials.
3. When simplifying expressions, it is important to identify and combine like monomials correctly.
4. The coefficient in a monomial indicates how many times the term is multiplied by its variable.
5. Graphing a monomial function can reveal its behavior across different values in the coordinate plane.
