

MONOPODIAL

Meaning: Monopodial refers to a growth pattern characterized by a single main stem or axis that extends vertically, with lateral branches arising from it, often used in artistic or botanical contexts to denote a singular focus or structure.

1. The artist chose a monopodial approach to emphasize the singular focus of her sculpture.
2. In botany, certain plants exhibit monopodial growth, developing a single central stem with lateral branches.
