

MORALIZER

Meaning: A moralizer is a person who expresses strong moral views or attempts to teach others about ethics, often in a way that can be perceived as preachy or self-righteous.

1. The teacher was often seen as a moralizer, always eager to impart life lessons to her students.
2. In discussions of ethics, he sometimes came off as a moralizer, making others uncomfortable with his strong opinions.
3. Her tendency to moralize about every situation made it difficult for her friends to open up to her.
4. Rather than being a helpful guide, his constant moralizing alienated those who just wanted to share their experiences.
5. The novel featured a character who served as a moralizer, challenging the protagonist's values at every turn.
