*Meaning: To mythologize means to create or promote myths about someone or something, often elevating them to a legendary or divine status that may distort reality.*

1. Many cultures tend to mythologize their heroes, elevating them to almost divine status.
2. Some historians argue that we should not mythologize events of the past, as it can distort our understanding of history.
3. The way the media mythologizes celebrities often creates unrealistic expectations for their lives.
4. In literature, authors frequently mythologize ordinary experiences, transforming them into epic narratives.
5. As societies evolve, they often mythologize their origins to reinforce a sense of identity and belonging.
