

# NACRE

*Meaning: Nacre is a smooth, iridescent substance produced by some mollusks, forming the inner layer of their shells and often seen as a decorative material in jewelry.*

1. The interior of the seashell glimmered with the soft luster of nacre.
2. Her necklace was adorned with pearls set in a backdrop of iridescent nacre.
3. The artist chose nacre to create a stunning inlay on the wooden surface of the table.
4. During the jewelry exhibition, the shimmering nacre captivated the attention of all the visitors.
5. The ancient Greeks valued nacre, believing it held protective qualities against evil spirits.
