Meaning: Namable (adjective): capable of being identified, labeled, or expressed in words.

1. A concept so abstract can often feel namable only in poetry.
2. The artist struggled to find a namable emotion that captured her experience.
3. In his speech, he used a namable term to describe the complex phenomenon.
4. The scientist proposed a new theory but had difficulty finding a namable definition.
5. Some feelings are deeply personal and resist being given a namable label.
