

NECROTIC

Meaning: Necrotic refers to tissue that has died or is undergoing decay, often due to lack of blood supply or infection.

1. The necrotic tissue in the wound required immediate medical intervention.
2. As the infection spread, the doctor noted the formation of necrotic areas that could jeopardize her health.
3. In advanced cases of the disease, patients may experience necrotic lesions that necessitate surgical removal.
4. The necrotic cells released toxins that further complicated the patient's recovery process.
5. After the frostbite, the necrotic fingers had to be amputated to prevent further complications.
