

NECROTOMY

Meaning: Necrotomy is the surgical procedure of cutting into or removing necrotic (dead) tissue to assess damage or prevent complications.

1. The pathologist performed a necrotomy to study the extent of tissue damage caused by the infection.
2. In cases of severe necrosis, a necrotomy may be necessary to remove dead tissue and prevent further complications.
3. The findings from the necrotomy revealed critical insights into the patient's underlying health issues.
4. During the necrotomy, the surgeon carefully documented the different stages of tissue decay.
5. A necrotomy is often a crucial procedure in forensic investigations to determine the cause of death.
