Meaning: Negate: to make something ineffective or invalid; to nullify or counteract.

1. The evidence presented in court could potentially negate the defendant's guilt.
2. Her cheerful demeanor seemed to negate any lingering doubts about the project's success.
3. To negate the effects of the medication, the doctor recommended a change in diet.
4. His apology did little to negate the hurt feelings caused by his earlier remarks.
5. The new policy aims to negate any unfair advantages in the hiring process.
