

NIBBED

Meaning: NIBBED (verb): To shape or refine the tip of a writing instrument or brush to enhance precision in detail or line work.

1. The artist carefully nibbed the tip of her brush to achieve fine details in her painting.
2. He nibbed the quill before writing his final thoughts in the leather-bound journal.
3. After he nibbed the fountain pen, the ink flowed smoothly onto the page.
4. In calligraphy, the way you nibbed the pen can dramatically affect the stroke's thickness.
5. She decided to nibbed the pencil to create a sharper point for her sketching.
