

NIDIFICATE

Meaning: NIDIFICATE (verb): to build or establish a nest for breeding, particularly in the context of birds.

1. Birds typically nidificate in the spring when food is abundant.
2. The conservation team studied the nesting habits of species that nidificate in urban areas.
3. In the tropical rainforest, many species nidificate in the dense foliage to protect their young.
