Meaning: NIDUS: a central point or source from which something, such as infection or corruption, originates or develops.

1. The researcher focused on the nidus of infection in order to develop an effective treatment.
2. A nidus of corruption had formed within the organization, undermining its credibility.
3. In biology, the term nidus often refers to a site where pathogens can multiply and thrive.
4. The artist found inspiration in the nidus of creativity that emerged from her travels.
5. Understanding the nidus of a problem is essential for finding a lasting solution.
