*Meaning: NIMIETY: an excess or surplus of something, often leading to confusion or overwhelm.*

1. The nimiety of details in her presentation left the audience feeling overwhelmed.
2. He realized that the nimiety of choices at the buffet was both a blessing and a curse.
3. The nimiety of evidence presented in the trial ultimately swayed the jury's decision.
4. In literature, a nimiety of adjectives can detract from the clarity of the narrative.
5. The project was hindered by a nimiety of conflicting opinions among team members.
