Meaning: Nix (verb): to reject, cancel, or put an end to something.

2. She wanted to go out for dinner, but the rain made her nix the plan.
3. After reviewing the budget, the manager had to nix several unnecessary expenses.
4. His suggestion to change the project timeline was quickly nixed by the team.
5. Despite initial excitement, they ultimately chose to nix the event due to low interest.
