Meaning: NOMINALLY: in name only; officially or theoretically, but not in practice or reality.

1. The committee is nominally responsible for overseeing the budget, but its influence has waned over the years.
2. Nominally, the project is under the direction of the new manager, although the previous leader still has significant sway.
3. She is nominally an expert in the field, but her recent work has raised questions about her qualifications.
4. The country is nominally a democracy, yet many believe that true power lies with a select few.
5. Nominally, the software is free, but hidden fees often arise during the registration process.
