

NONCONCURRENCE

Meaning: Nonconcurrence refers to the state of disagreement or lack of agreement among members or parties regarding a decision or proposal.

1. The board's nonconcurrence with the proposed budget left many members frustrated.
2. In cases of nonconcurrence, the committee must hold additional discussions to reach a consensus.
3. The nonconcurrence of the two parties resulted in a prolonged negotiation process.
4. She expressed her nonconcurrence with the decision during the meeting, emphasizing her concerns.
5. The judge noted the nonconcurrence of the expert witnesses as a critical factor in the trial.

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
