Meaning: "Nonne" is an informal variation of "don't," used to seek agreement or confirmation in a rhetorical question.

1. Nonne you think it would be wise to reconsider that decision?
2. She asked him, "Nonne you remember the last time we were here?"
3. In the debate, the speaker posed a question, "Nonne we owe it to ourselves to seek the truth?"
4. His expression suggested doubt, as if he wanted to say, "Nonne that's a bit far-fetched?"
5. "Nonne you agree that this approach could lead to better results?" she challenged him.
