

NONRECURRENT

Meaning: Nonrecurrent refers to costs or issues that occur only once and are not expected to happen again in the future.

1. The nonrecurrent costs of the project exceeded our initial budget estimates.
2. Her nonrecurrent health issues made it difficult for her to maintain a consistent work schedule.
3. The company's nonrecurrent expenses this quarter were significantly lower than last year's.
4. Investors were wary of the nonrecurrent nature of the revenue reported in the last financial statement.
5. The nonrecurrent events in the market led to a temporary spike in consumer confidence.
