

NUGATION

Meaning: Nugation is the act of nullifying or denying a previously established agreement or proposition.

1. Nugation of the previous agreement left the parties in a state of confusion.
2. In philosophy, nugation often refers to the denial of a previously asserted proposition.
3. The lawyer argued that the nugation of the contract was necessary due to unforeseen circumstances.
4. After much debate, the committee reached a consensus on the nugation of outdated policies.
