

NUMBEDNESS

Meaning: Numbedness is the state of being emotionally or physically insensitive or unresponsive, often resulting from trauma or medication.

1. The numbedness she felt after the accident made it difficult for her to process her emotions.
2. As the medication took effect, a sense of numbedness settled over him, dulling both pain and anxiety.
3. In moments of grief, the numbedness can sometimes offer a temporary respite from overwhelming sorrow.
4. He tried to shake off the numbedness that had crept in after spending too long in isolation.
5. The numbedness in her fingertips was a sign that she needed to warm up before continuing to paint.
