

OAKUM

Meaning: Oakum is a fibrous material made from old rope or hemp, used in boatbuilding to caulk seams and create watertight seals.

1. The shipwright carefully twisted the oakum into strands before sealing the seams of the hull.
2. In traditional boatbuilding, oakum is used to ensure a watertight seal between the planks.
3. The old sailor taught the apprentice how to prepare oakum for the upcoming repairs.
