Meaning: Obdurate: stubbornly refusing to change one's opinion or course of action despite persuasion or evidence.

1. Despite the overwhelming evidence presented, he remained obdurate, refusing to change his mind.
2. Her obdurate stance on the issue made it difficult for the team to reach a consensus.
3. Even in the face of compassion, the villain was obdurate, showing no signs of remorse.
4. The child's obdurate nature often led to conflicts with his more flexible peers.
5. In negotiations, his obdurate attitude hindered any possibility of a compromise.
