Meaning: Obdurateness refers to the quality of being stubbornly resistant to change or persuasion, often characterized by a refusal to soften one's stance or admit fault.

1. Her obdurateness in refusing to compromise made negotiations nearly impossible.
2. Despite the mounting evidence, his obdurateness kept him from admitting he was wrong.
3. The obdurateness of the committee members frustrated those who sought a more flexible approach.
4. Even in the face of overwhelming compassion, her obdurateness remained unyielding.
5. The teacher admired the student's passion but was concerned about his obdurateness towards feedback.
