Meaning: OBJURGATORY: expressing strong disapproval or criticism; scolding.

1. The teacher's objurgatory remarks made the students realize the seriousness of their mistakes.
2. His objurgatory tone during the meeting left everyone feeling uncomfortable and chastised.
3. Despite her objurgatory style, her intentions were simply to encourage her team to improve.
4. The manager's objurgatory feedback was meant to push the employees towards excellence, though it felt harsh.
5. In an objurgatory fashion, the critic tore apart the artist's latest work, sparing no detail in his assessment.
