Meaning: To feel compelled to act in a certain way or to require someone to do something due to a moral or legal duty.

1. I felt obliged to help my neighbor after he assisted me during the storm.
2. The company's policies oblige employees to complete training each year.
3. She was obliged to accept the invitation, even though she had other plans.
4. Parents often feel obliged to provide for their children's education and well-being.
5. The contract will oblige the contractor to finish the project by the deadline.
