Meaning: Obliquity refers to the state of being tilted or slanted, particularly in relation to the Earth's axis or to a deviation from straightforwardness in thought or reasoning.

1. The obliquity of the Earth's axis contributes significantly to the changing seasons.
2. In philosophy, the obliquity of thought can sometimes lead to innovative perspectives.
3. The artist's obliquity in his approach to the subject matter captivated the audience.
4. Scientists study the obliquity of celestial bodies to understand their orbital dynamics.
5. Her obliquity in addressing the issue raised more questions than it answered.
