

OBOVAL

Meaning: Oboval refers to a shape that is broader at one end and tapering towards the other, resembling an elongated oval.

1. The leaves of the plant are oboval in shape, resembling an elongated oval.
2. In botanical studies, the term 'oboval' is often used to describe certain fruit shapes.
3. She admired the oboval stones scattered along the riverbank, each one unique and smooth.
