

OBSCURANTIST

Meaning: Obscurantist: a person or philosophy that deliberately prevents or restricts understanding and knowledge, often by promoting confusion or complexity.

1. The obscurantist philosophy often seeks to shroud knowledge in mystery rather than promote understanding.
2. Critics argue that the politician's obscurantist rhetoric is designed to confuse rather than clarify important issues.
3. In an age of information, the rise of obscurantist movements poses a significant challenge to public discourse.

5. Many artists intentionally adopt an obscurantist style to provoke deeper thought and interpretation among their audience.
