

OBSUREMENT

Meaning: Obsurement refers to the act of making something unclear or difficult to perceive, often resulting in confusion or misinformation.

1. The obsurement of truth in the media often leads to widespread misinformation.
2. His mind was clouded by the obsurement of his emotions, making it hard for him to think clearly.
3. The fog created an obsurement that made it difficult for drivers to see the road ahead.
4. In the debate, the candidate's use of jargon served as an obsurement of their actual policy positions.
5. The artist intentionally chose obsurement in her painting to provoke thought and introspection.
