Meaning: Obscuring refers to the act of making something unclear or difficult to see or understand.

1. The dense fog was obscuring the view of the mountains in the distance.
2. Her emotions were obscuring her judgment, making it difficult for her to decide.
3. The artist intentionally used shadow and light, obscuring certain details to create mystery.
4. Political rhetoric often serves to obscure the truth rather than clarify it.
5. In the darkness of the room, the flickering candlelight was obscuring the faces of the guests.
