Meaning: Obsequent refers to behavior or actions that follow or are subsequent to something, often characterized by compliance or agreement.

1. The obsequent behavior of the employee impressed his manager during the evaluation.
2. In an obsequent manner, she nodded in agreement with every point he made.
3. The obsequent nature of the followers often led them to overlook their leader's flaws.
4. During the meeting, his obsequent comments reflected a desire to please rather than to disagree.
5. Her obsequent attitude made it difficult for her to voice her own opinions.
